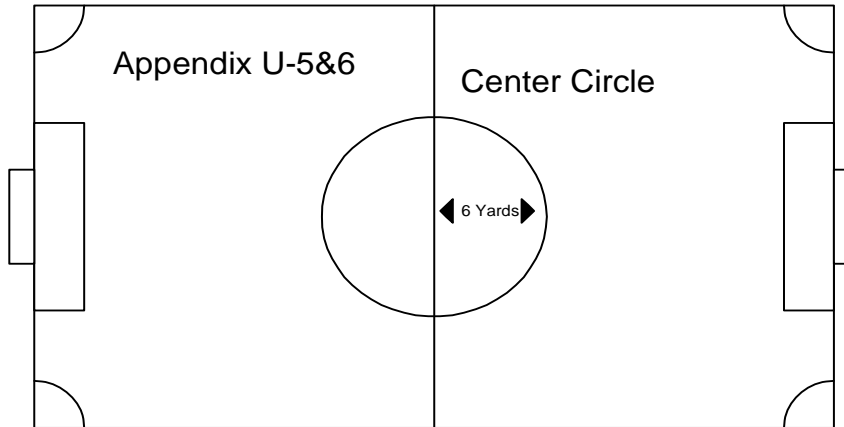


Barstow Youth Soccer U-5&6 Appendix



Law I – THE FIELD

A. Dimensions:

The Field of play shall be rectangular, Its length being Not more than 50 yards nor less then 40 yards and its Width not more than 30 yards nor less than 20 yards. The length in all cases shall exceed the width.

B. MARKINGS:

1. Distinctive lines not more than five (5) inches wide.
2. A halfway line shall be marked out across the field.
3. A center circle with a Five (5) yard radius.
4. Four corner arcs with two (2) foot radius.
5. Goal area Three (3) yards from each goal post and (3) Yards into the field of play, joined by a line drawn parallel with the goal line.

C. GOALS:

Maximum: Five feet high and Ten feet wide.
Minimum: The size of a hockey goal.

LAW II- The Ball Size Three (3)

LAW III – Number of Players.

A. Maximum number of players on the field at anyone time is Five (5).One of whom is the goal keeper. USYSA recommends that the goal keeper position not be the responsibility of one player, but all team members take turns.

B. Maximum number of players on the roster should not exceed Ten (10).

C. Substitution:

- 1 After an injury, but only the injured player may be subbed.
2. At the quarter
3. At half- time

D. Playing Time: Each player SHALL play a minimum of 50% of the total playing time.

E. Teams and games may be Co-Ed

LAW IV- Players Equipment

Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

- A: Footwear Tennis shoe or soft cleated soccer shoes.
B: Shin Guards are **Mandatory**
C: Socks must be over shin guards.

LAW V -REFEREE

Registered referee/new referee program
Coach /Parent or Jr referee
All rules infractions shall be briefly explained to the offending player.

Law VI -LINESMAN:

Coach /Parent or Jr referee

Law VII- DURATION OF GAME

- A: The game shall be divided into four(4) equal Quarters of Ten (10) minutes each.
B: There shall be two (2) minute breaks between quarters 1&2 and 3&4
C: There shall be a half time break of five (5) minutes between 2&3

LAW VIII -START OF PLAY

Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

A: Opponent must be five (5) yards from the center mark while kick off is in progress

LAW IX -BALL IN AND OUT OF PLAY

Conform to FIFA

LAW X -METHOD OF SCORING

No score recorded

LAW XI -OFF SIDES

There shall be no off sides

LAW XII -FOULS AND MISCONDUCT

Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

A: All fouls shall result in an indirect free kick with the opponents Five (5) yards away.

B: The referee must explain all infractions to the offending player

C: No Free kicks shall be taken inside the defenders goal area. (Ball Must Be Moved Outside Goal Area)

LAW XIII- FREE KICKS

Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

A: Shall be classified under one heading-indirect

B: A goal may not be scored until the ball has been touched by second player from either team.

C: No Free kicks shall be taken by the attacking team inside the defenders goal area.

LAW XIV- PENALTY KICKS

No penalty Kicks are to be taken during these games.

LAW XV- THROW IN

Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

A: A second throw in must be allowed if a player commits a foul on the initial attempt.

The referee shall explain the proper method before allowing the player to re-throw.

LAW XVI - GOAL KICK

Conform to FIFA with the following exceptions:

A: Goal kick may be taken from any point inside the goal area.

B: Opponents must be five yards away from ball.

LAW XVII- CORNER KICK

A: There are no Corner Kicks.

B: Restart with Goal Kick.

Opposing Coaches & Players shall shake hands after each game. DO NOT RECORD FINAL SCORE
